**ABSORPTION SCHEME FOR STUDENTS OF OLD COURSE OF LL.B 3 YEARS  
INTO NEW CREDIT BASED SEMESER SYSTEM**

1. The students of the course immediately preceding the course under this direction shall be given chance to appear for three more consecutive examination according to old syllabus and regulations under Direction No. 4 of 2009. However , Students who had taken admission in the session 2011-12 shall be governed by syllabus and course structure provided under this direction from 2012 -13 session i.e from their semester III onward with necessary minor adjustment provided in the absorption scheme. The Results of Ist and IInd Semester of such students will be converted into suitable grads and SGPA .

Those students who are required to clear their course in three consecutive attempt as per this clause but failed to do so will be required to take admission afresh in the course provided under this direction. Such students shall not be entitled to claim exemption from any paper or subject in which they might have passed.

2. The absorption of the students of old course referred above shall be made in the following manner:
